TOTAL SKILL SCHOOL

Our day camps focus on defensive and offensive skills. We cover infield, outfield, hitting (some hitting drills dependent on cage space availability), baserunning, sliding, and diving. The Total Skills School would not include Pitching and Catching.

PITCHER/CATCHER SCHOOL

These day camps focus on the mechanical and mental aspects of becoming a pitcher or catcher, as well as pitcher-catcher defense and hitting (some hitting drills depend on cage availability).

ROOKIE SCHOOL

Building a solid foundation early is the key to success. The Rookie School teaches sound FUNDamentals while having competitive fun! From tee to toss-in hitting and from release to plate pitch strategy, the Rookie School instructs from the ground up. The Rookie School

would be scheduled as a 2-hour session with 45 minutes of defense (including overhand throwing), 45 minutes of hitting, and an option for 30 minutes of Pitching!

REQUIREMENTS

HOMETOWN FIELD - PFP requires a properly maintained, safe softball complex. Based on the projected camp size, a multi-field complex or a location with auxiliary open grassy space may be needed. Any costs associated with the field usage are the responsibility of the organizer.

RAIN/SEVERE WEATHER - Planet Fastpitch can act as a backup weather facility (pending availability).

GENERAL LIABILITY WAIVER AND HEALTH FORM - All necessary paperwork and information required will be sent in player confirmation messages. These materials include a health form & general liability waiver, directions, and emergency contact information.
